A 6 week course diving into the world of colour theory and its impact on our everyday lives.

Each week students will be introduced to a new lesson with a creative exercise to work on in class. In addition to weekly journal assignments to be completed outside of class time. This will further our knowledge on each weeks subject and support our growing imaginations for the creative process.

By the end of the course, students will feel confident with their colour theory knowledge, with a variety of visual exercises to show their progress with a completed masterpiece to hang on their wall.

## Lesson 1 - Colour Wheel

We will be exploring the colour wheel during our first class and create our own using mixed media.

Exploration of the many colour themes will be introduced including; primary, secondary, warm, cool, complimentary, analogous, triadic and more.

Students will receive a colour theory booklet to use for future reference, with additional handouts to be added.

Art journal homework will be given.

## Lesson 2 - Colour and Emotions

Colours have the ability evoke a variety of emotions within ourselves. We will be going over the psychology of colour and the impact they have on the atmosphere around them.

Students will be introduced to some painting techniques and begin work on their mood paintings in class.

Art journal homework will be given.



### **Lesson 3 - Colour Assessment**

How do we know what colours work and what colours don't?

Why do some colours together inspire us?

Why do some colours together make me feel overwhelmed?

We will discuss how colours can compliment one another and how certain pairing of colours may provide an visual unsettling effect.

### **Lesson 4 - Glazing and Blending**

Students will be introduced to more painting techniques to develop our strengths to prepare for our main paintings.

We will work with acrylics to experiment with glazing and blending, along with discussion on how our art journal homework went.

### **Lesson 5 - Colour Palettes**

Students will create their own colour palettes and explore mark making.

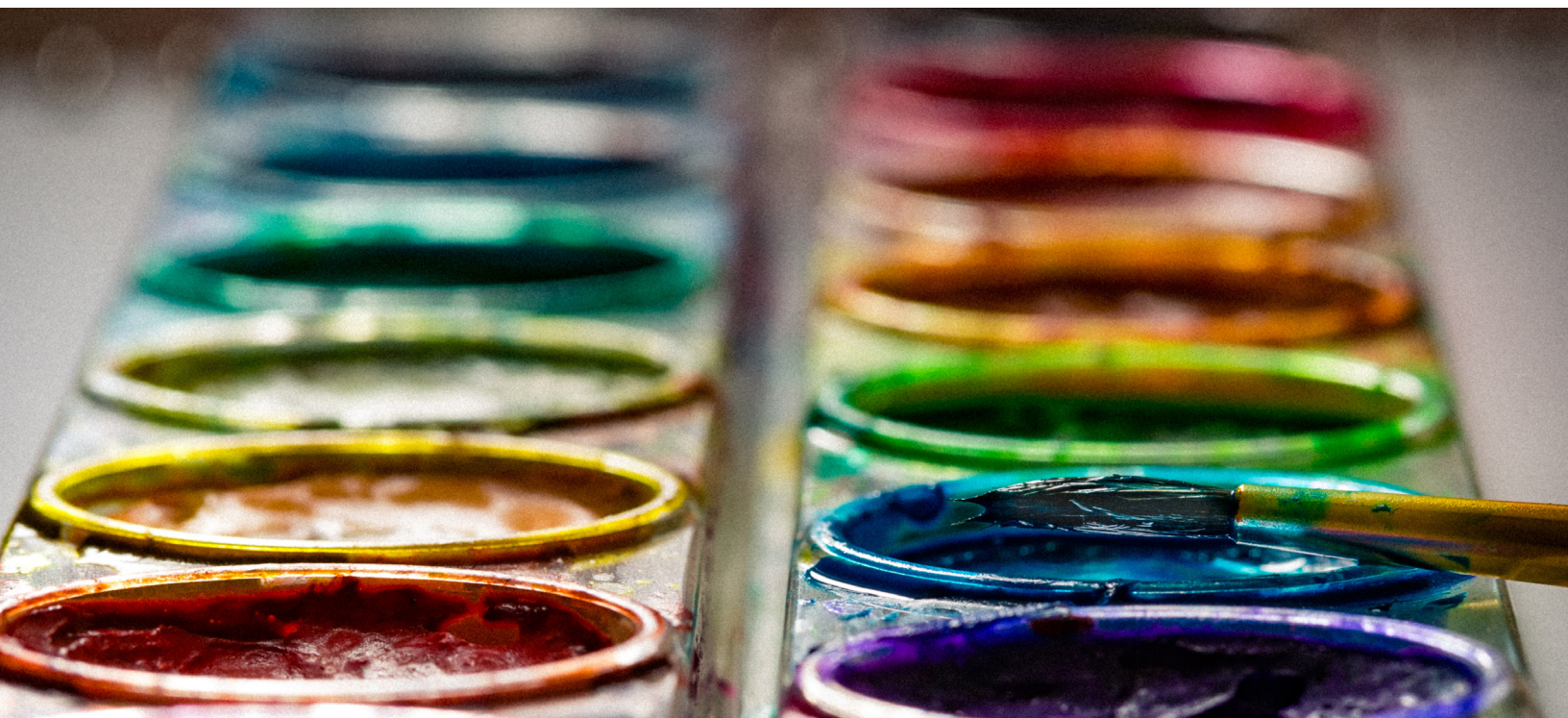
Introduction to our final masterpiece painting, which we will continue working on during lesson 6.
